- LEAP has graduated 12 students since March 2020

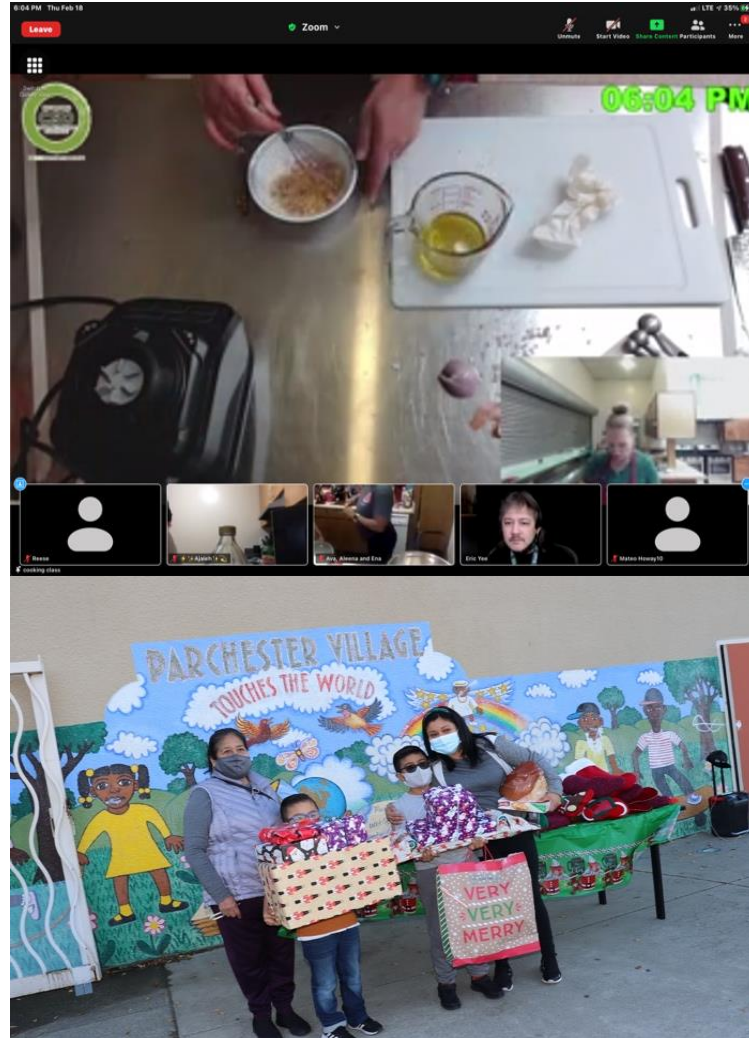


LEAP (LITERACY FOR EVERY ADULT PROGRAM)
