**Prohibited items include:** \*Batteries\*Bug Spray\*Concrete\*E-Waste\*Fluorescent Lights\*Oil\*Oven Cleaner\*Paint\*Propane Tanks\*Tires.

Curbside pick-up for seniors/disabled residents will take place on Friday, July 23 between 8:00 am and 2:30 pm. Pick-ups are limited to no more than a pickup truckload per location. 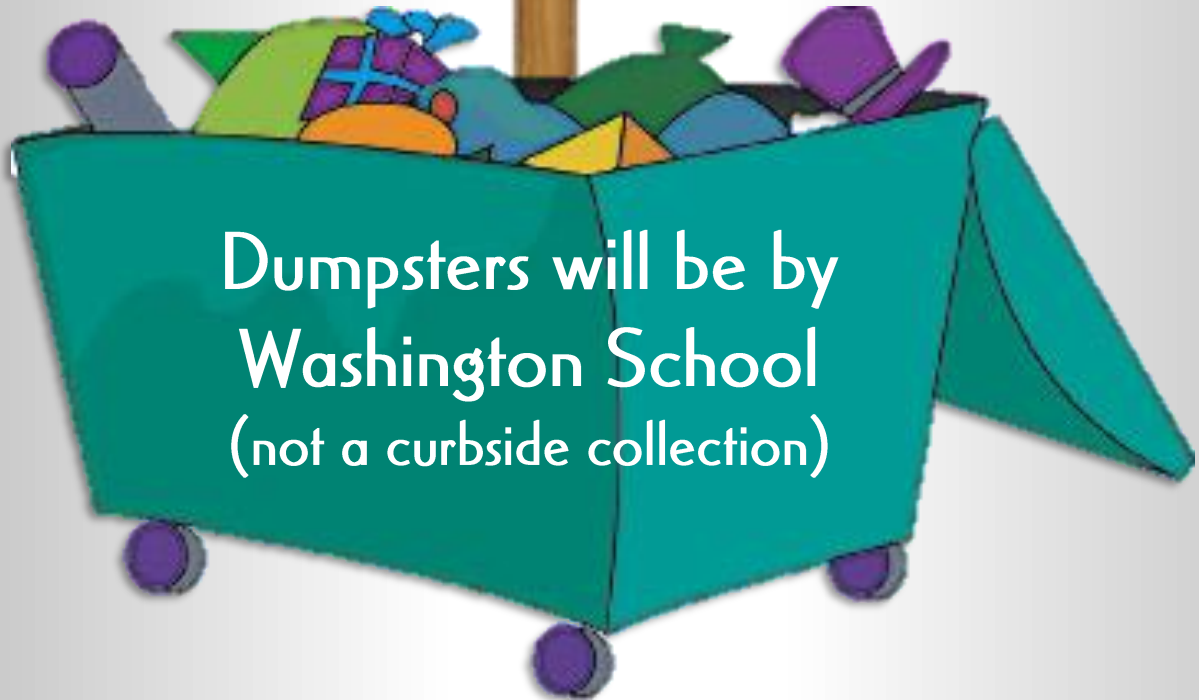
