The Point Richmond Neighborhood Council (PRNC) is a volunteer organization dedicated to helping residents of Point Richmond thrive. Meeting topics include building and construction projects, roads and community safety, environmental and health issues, and social and recreational activities.

What do you do?

We sponsor local organizations and non-profits for events such as the annual Spring Fling, and art and community events such as the December Arts of Point Richmond Holiday Faire and the Point Richmond Summer Music Festival. We are currently working on a grant for repair of the Ferry Point tunnel mural.

When are meetings?

Meetings are held most months, currently via Zoom, and are open to the public, but only active members can vote on issues. We bring community requests to the table and frequently have city staff and management present.
